REGISTRATION

- Purchase a registration form and complete it along with:
- Copy of transcript and certificate of bachelor degree (\$1 certificate) with a minimum cumulative achievement of at least 2.75
- 1 colored copy of legal Family Card (KK) and 1 colored copy of Birth Certificate (Akte Kelahiran)
- 1 colored copy of ID Card (KTP)
- Declaration of school tuition payment
- Recommendation letters (at least 2 letters)
- Health letter from a doctor
- 3 pieces of color photos (3cm x 4cm)
- Follow the entrance test (Interview, Reading and Writing)

CURRICULUM

This 44-credit, 24-month program helps students enhance their knowledge and skills in English and ELT so that they are competent at any levels of education. To prepare students for the program, non-credit matriculation courses consisting of Writing Workshop and Introduction to Linguistics are given one month before the regular class starts. To ensure that the students earn knowledge and skills, quizzes, tests, and final evaluation in the form of project paper are administered.

MATRICULATION

The matriculation courses are designed to equip new students with knowledge in English linguistics and skills of writing. To ensure that the students earn knowledge and skills, the lecturers will administer a quiz at the end of a meeting and a final evaluation in the form of project paper at the end of the courses.
